**Morris Nelson**

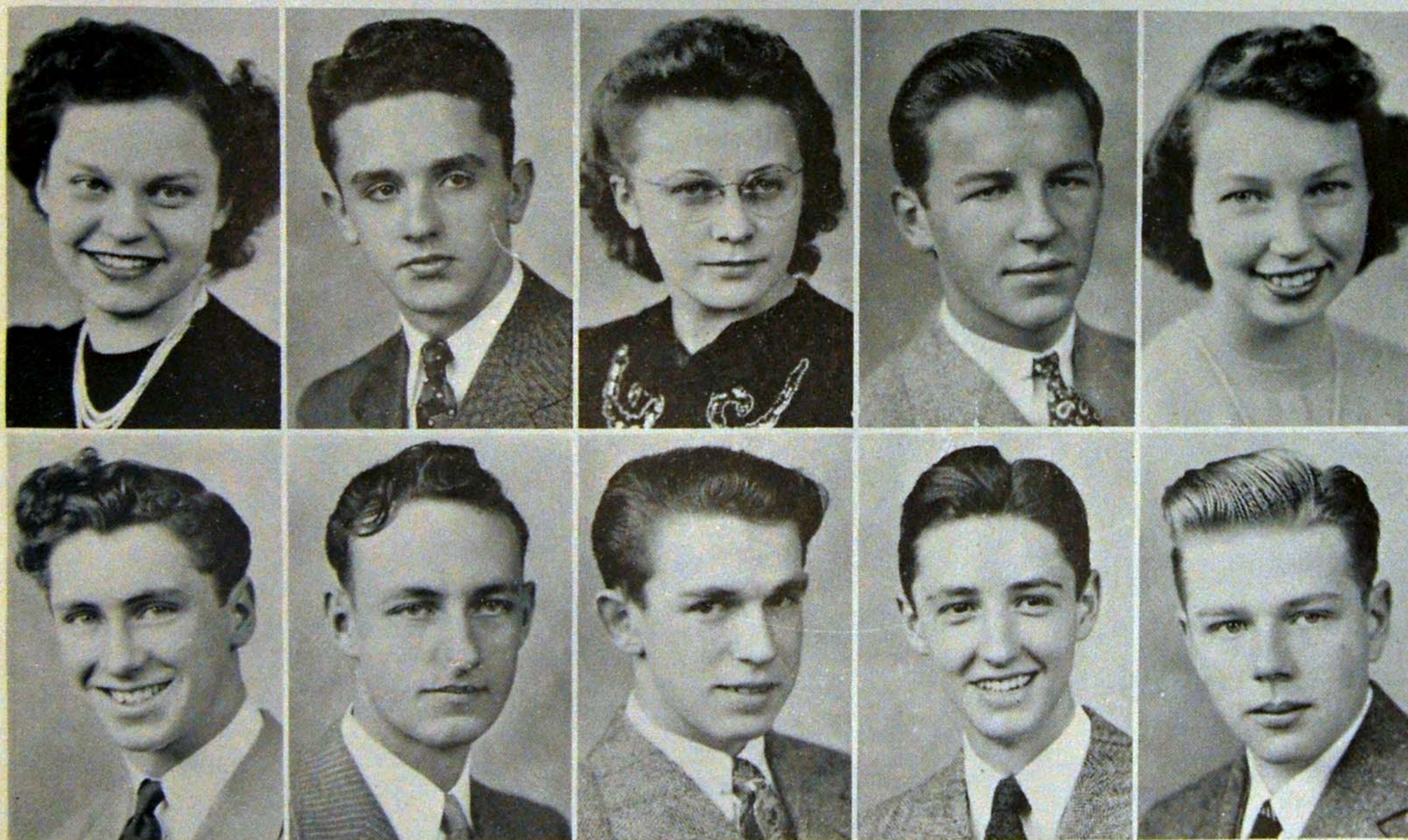
*From coast to coast he came
