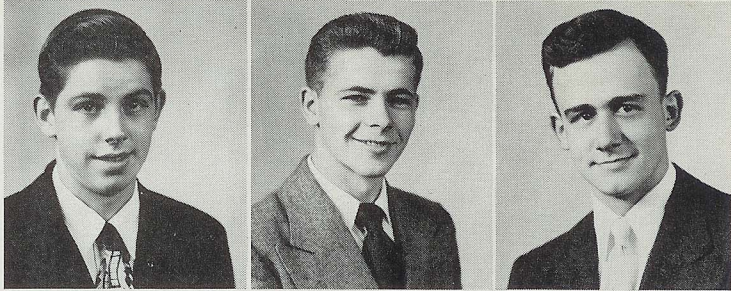
HAROLD HILLER—"A man in the true sense of the term"

HOWARD HOLMES — "He has no thought of the future, he is happy and glad and free."

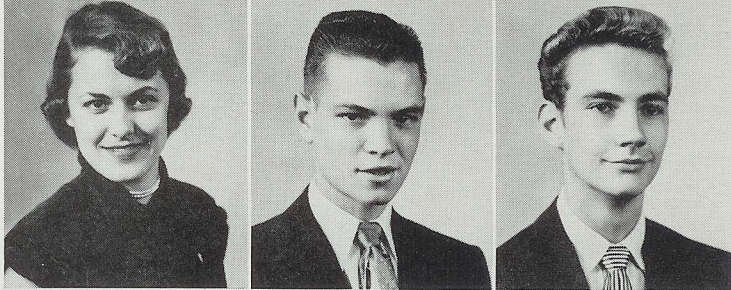
BOB HOLOWELL — "Why study? The more we study the more there is to forget."

KEN HUFFMAN—"Is this a dream? O, if it be a dream let me sleep on, and do not wake me yet."

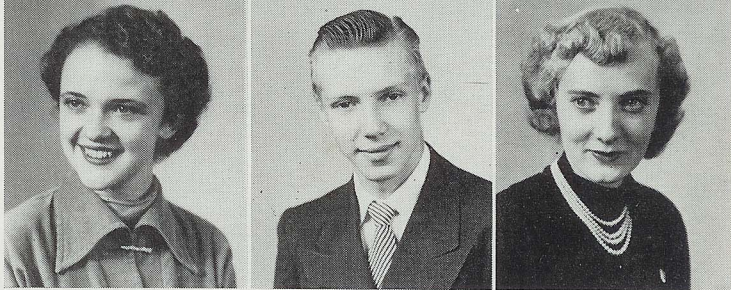
RONALD HUTSLER — "Full well they laughed at all his jokes for many a joke had he."
