To all students in L.H.S.,

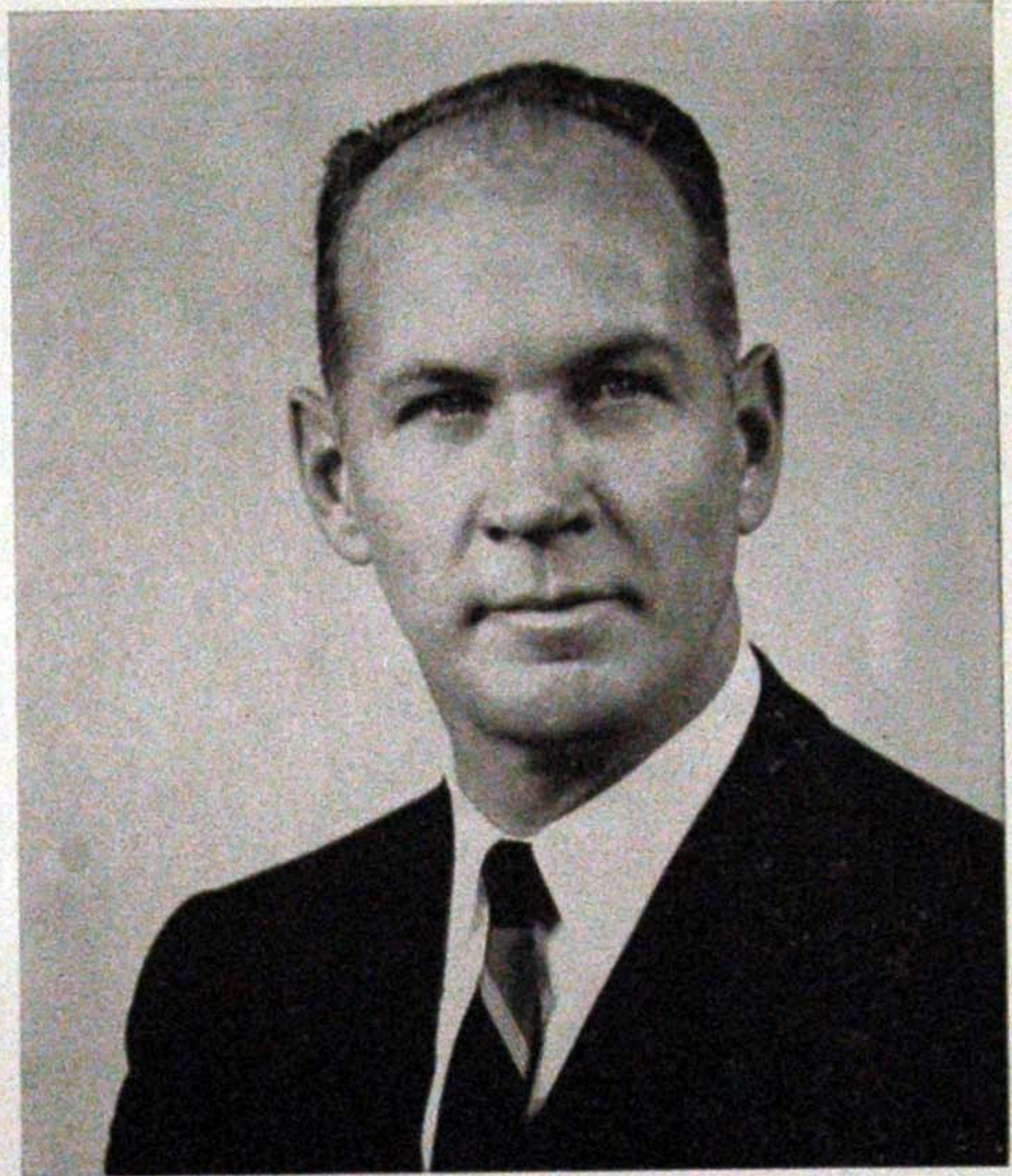

To our 1956 Seniors, may you have the very best of everything in whatever you choose to do. We trust that the educational background you have received will prove to be a solid foundation upon which to build further.

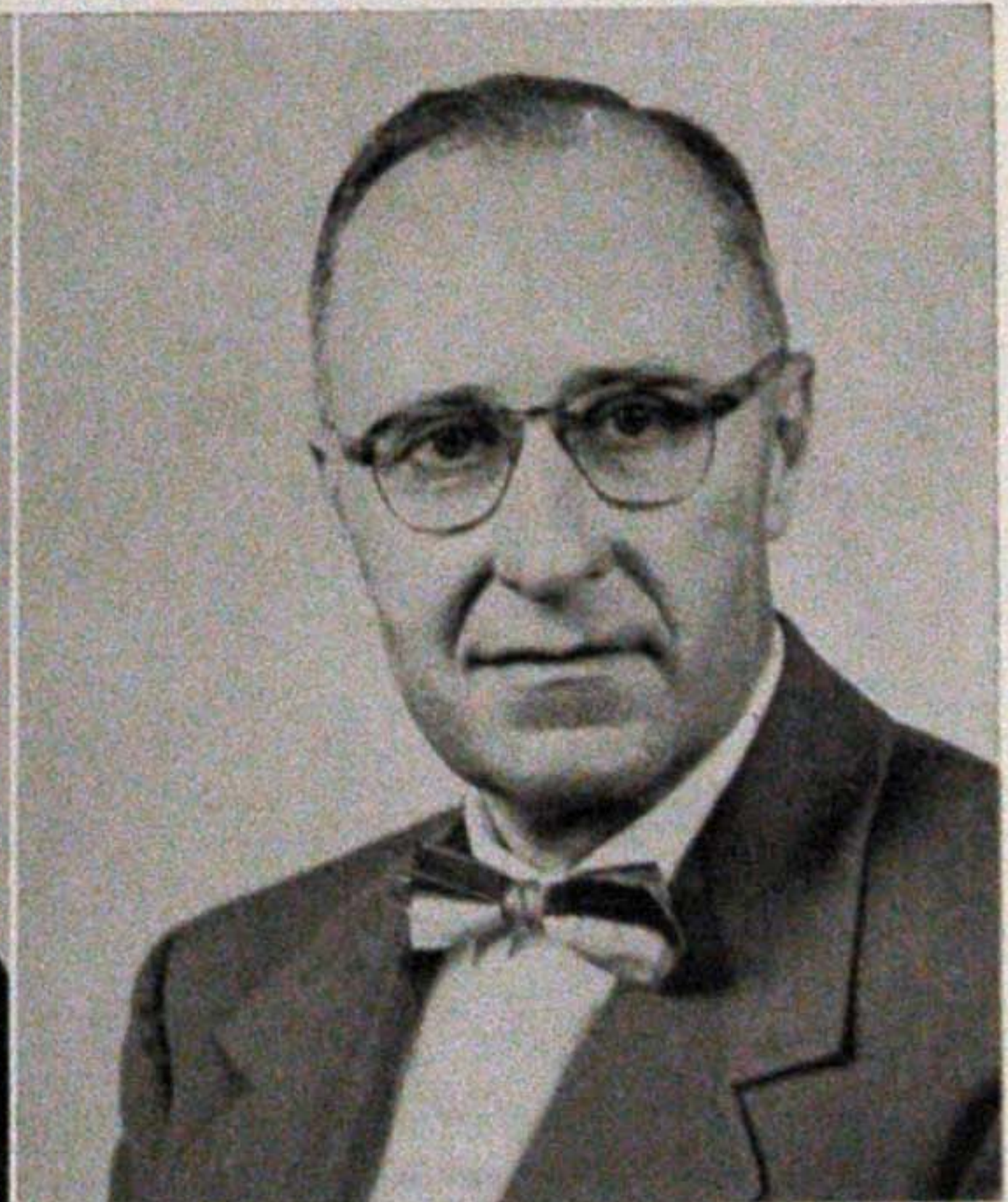
