A native of Lancaster and graduate of Lancaster High School and Ohio State University College of Law, Mr. Hoffman was a practicing attorney in Pittsburgh for many years before retirement. He owned considerable property in Lancaster and Columbus and just last summer sold the Georgian to Fairfield Heritage Assn. He also has a home on E. Main St. across from Fairfield County Court House but had made his home in Winter Park, Fla., in recent years with a niece. Survivors include two nieces, Mrs. W.
