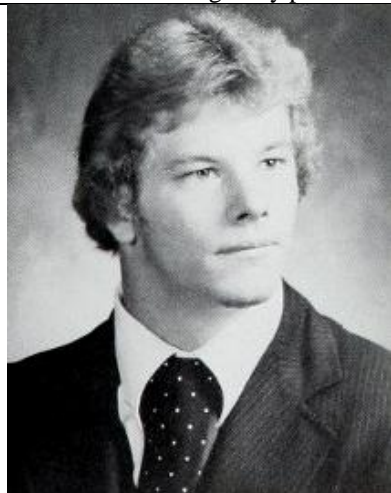

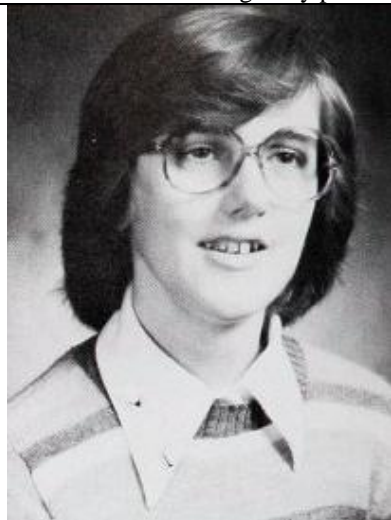

Bill was much loved and will be missed by all who knew him.

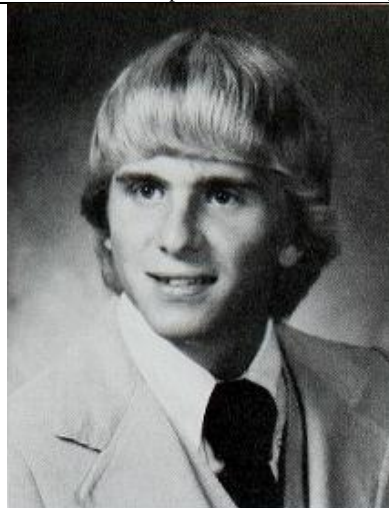

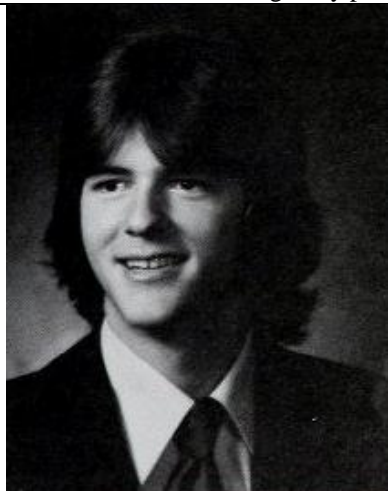
She was preceded in death by an infant son, Mark and father, William I. Caldwell.

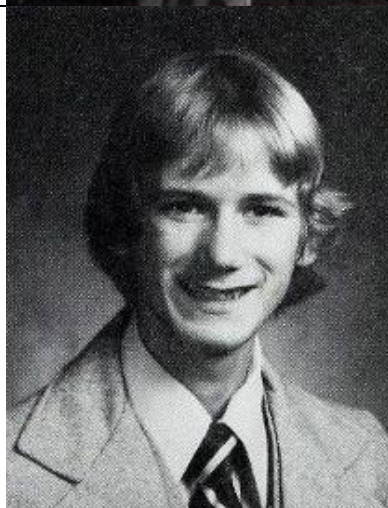

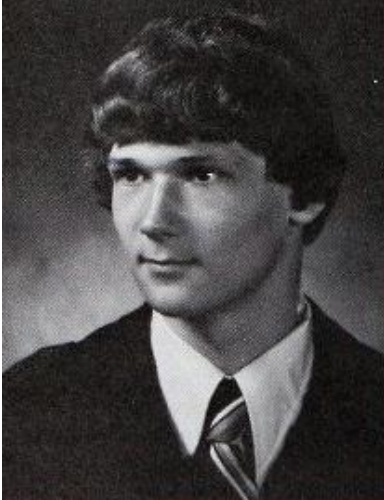
