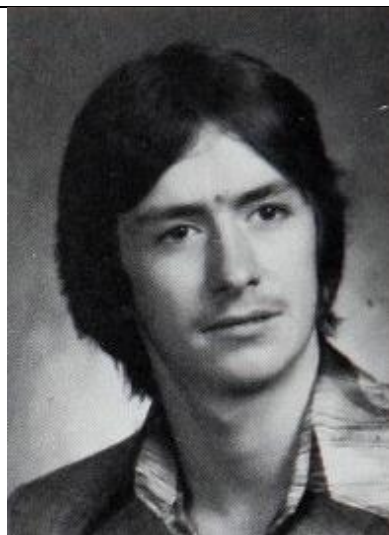

He was born Nov. 6, 1961, in Torrance, Calif., a son of Marvin Stine and the late Melba (Eades) Stine.

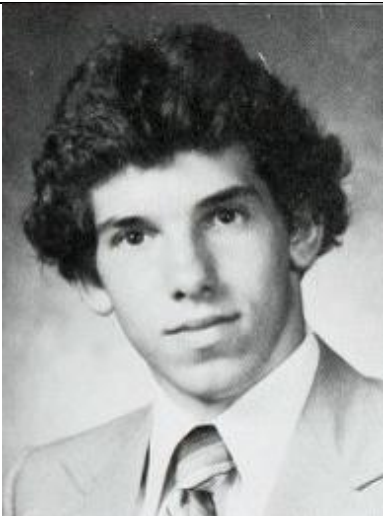

She was preceded in death by her father and mother, Don and Dee Muenstermann; and brother, Karl Muenstermann.

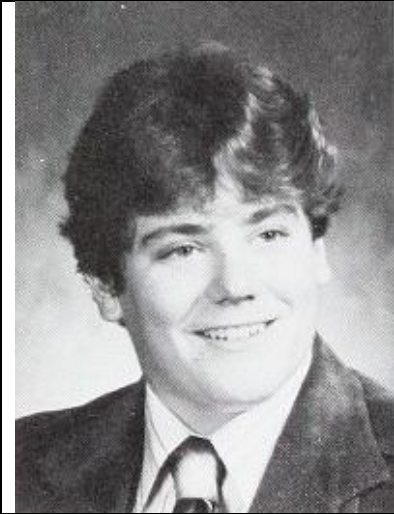
